Experts meet in Parliament to discuss rendition

**Work of All Party Parliamentary Group on Extraordinary Rendition
gathering pace**

MPs and Peers from the All Party Parliamentary Group on Extraordinary Rendition met today with non-governmental organisations and lawyers to create a unique 'working group' which aimed to make concrete suggestions about how to take forward the investigations into UK involvement or complicity in the practice of Extraordinary rendition.

Chairman of the All Party Parliamentary Group, Andrew Tyrie, said:

'We had three main objectives. The first is to work on proposals which can be put to the government which, if implemented, will make it more likely that any renditions which take place on UK territory will be identified. These may include better record keeping and spot checks. Secondly, we discussed ways in which to bring greater awareness about the unlawful nature of rendition activity, particularly to those who might find themselves involved. Thirdly, we discussed how, by pooling our resources, we could obtain better quality and more detailed information about allegations of rendition.'
