**Once again, MPs ask Condoleezza Rice to answer to Parliament  
about rendition flights**

Andrew Tyrie, Chairman of the All Party Parliamentary Group on Extraordinary Rendition, today invited US Secretary of State Condoleezza Rice to answer MPs questions about allegations of Extraordinary Rendition:

He said:

'It is important that the American administration does more to respond to these allegations of Extraordinary Rendition. I wrote to the Secretary of State Condoleezza Rice, on the 8<sup>th</sup> of December, asking her to come and discuss the matter with concerned MPs and Peers of the All Party Parliamentary Group on Extraordinary Rendition. I have had no response. That is why I have written to her again today.'

'Much damage to the standing of the West, and particularly the US and the UK has already been done by a lack of frankness on these issues. The damage has been most severe where it matters most – among the millions of moderate Muslims at home and abroad. The sooner we have more transparency the sooner we will have more trust.'
